We are licensed by the State of Connecticut and are open year-round, daily from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Our teaching staff is dedicated to nurturing your child in a family-like atmosphere. We strive to help your child learn age appropriate skills to further his/her whole development.

## Childcare (Ages 0-5)

- Available Monday — Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Parent-cargiver partnership based on mutual respect and understanding of child's needs
- Daily activities for **infants** encourage cognitive and socialization skills, along with fine and gross motor development.
- **Toddlers** engage in literacy/language development, early math/science, sensory and art experiences.
- Daily activities for **preschoolers** follow a structured curriculum that includes literacy, math, phonics, science, arts, music, dramatic play, sensory outdoor play, and block building
- Morning and afternoon snacks provided



## Ready Set for Kindergarten

**The Education Center at The New Milford United Methodist Church now offers a traditional and innovative morning preschool program for three and four-year olds.**

### Our program features:

- The program for 4-year-olds will be held on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 9 a.m. to noon. Three-year-olds will attend on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to noon.
- **Structured and creative curriculum**
- Kindergarten readiness skills in literacy, phonics, math, science, socialization and listening
- Activities include music, science, arts, sensory, fine/gross motor block building, multicultural, health, nutrition, character building, Jr. chefs, book club and field trips.
